### FROM THE SUPERVISOR'S DESK:

#### The Ups and Downs of Recycling

Over the last year, I've discussed the issue of recycling in the Town, as well as the nation. Everyone in our community has done a great job doing their part. In fact, statistics indicate that 25% of what is put to the curb each week is green bin recycling! I applaud all of you for your efforts.

The issue that we are currently experiencing is falling commodity prices. Prices for plastics, paper and metals are at historic lows. The severity of the commodities downturn is apparent when looking at the number of recycling facilities that have closed nationwide in recent years. Although prices right now are so low that it actually costs us money to recycle, we will continue to do our part to help our environment by maintaining a solid recycling plan. Every commodity/stock market experiences highs and lows. We will maintain a steady course and wait for the market to recover. As I've stated before, we all need to do our part to follow the recycling guidelines from the picture on the cart. Also, ensure our community's recycling is contaminant free by following the motto: "When in Doubt, Throw it Out".

**Remember...plastic bags and take out food containers go in the regular garbage NOT the recycle bin.**

#### Kinne Road Culvert

In early Spring, 2019, many of you know that the Town was forced to close the Kinne Road culvert due to safety concerns. After performing



an engineering study, we concluded that we had the expertise in-house to replace the culvert with our existing highway crew. We proceeded to purchase the required concrete culvert from a local business, our crews removed the failing one, and replaced it with the brand new one this August. The reason I mention all of this is to report to Town residents that we saved well over \$100,000 on this project by utilizing internal talent. We are fortunate to have very dedicated Town employees who continually take on whatever they can to give you the best service in Niagara County. Kudos to our highway crew for their work on this project.

  - By law, all cats, dogs and domesticated ferrets must have a current rabies vaccination from four months of age and on.
  - Cats and dogs receiving immunization WITHOUT PROOF of a previous rabies immunization will receive a certificate valid only for one year. Cats and dogs WITH PROOF of previous rabies immunizations will receive a certificate valid for three years.
  - Ferrets must receive vaccinations annually, regardless of previous immunization.
  - **All Animals** must be properly restrained. Cats & Ferrets must be in a box or carrier. Dogs must be leashed.
  - **The Department does not offer dog or cat vaccinations other than rabies. It is very important for the health and well being of your animal and the other animals attending our rabies clinics, that they have seen a veterinarian and are up to date on all of their immunizations, to include dog parvo virus.**
  - Volunteers are needed. Please call 439-7511 if interested.
  - It is requested that anyone bringing more than six animals to one clinic contact the Niagara County Department of Health at 439-7511 up to one week prior to the clinic so paperwork can be processed more efficiently.

## COMMUNITY MEETING MEDICARE HEALTH INSURANCE

Need help navigating the Medicare process? I am pleased to announce that the Town of Lockport will be hosting a Medicare Information Night on **Monday, October 21st from 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm. at Town Hall, 6560 Dysinger Rd.** This event will be held in collaboration with the Dale Association and the Niagara County Office for the Aging.

It will be informal and held in an open forum setting. You will receive information regarding the changes to Medicare, the Medicare Health Plans, Medicare Part D, NYS EPIC, and “Extra Help”, the Low Income Subsidy program. Attendees will be able to meet one on one with various representatives and providers.

- **Medicare Open Enrollment Period is October 15th – December 7th 2019**
- **Turning 65?** Your Initial Enrollment Period for Medicare Part A & B is based on the month in which you turn 65. It begins three months before your birth month and extends until three months after your birth month. Example: If you are born on June 18, 1955, your Initial Enrollment Period is from March 1, 2020 until September 30, 2020.

I encourage anyone approaching the age of 65 to attend. Medicare can be extremely confusing and we must always remember that ***knowledge is power.*** I look forward to seeing you on October 21st!

## INCOME LIMIT CHANGE FOR ENHANCED STAR

If you are currently receiving the BASIC STAR EXEMPTION, and will be turning 65 by December 31, 2020, you could be eligible for ENHANCED STAR.

The income limit for the 2020 school tax year is \$88,050, as verified by the 2018 Federal or State Income Tax Return. You must meet the income and residency requirements; and must apply by March 1, 2020.

If you are not on the IVP (Income Verification Program), Enhanced STAR renewal forms are mailed out after the 1st week of September

**STAR CHANGES** - New homeowners, or those who are new to STAR, must register with NYS; either by phone at 518-457-2036 or through their website at [www.tax.ny.gov/star](http://www.tax.ny.gov/star).

New applicants who register will now receive a check from NYS instead of receiving a credit on their school tax bill.

Those already active in the STAR/Enhanced STAR exemption are not affected by this change.

**OTHER STAR CHANGES** - ALL Enhanced STAR Exemption recipients MUST apply to the IVP (Income Verification Program), even if you don't file tax returns.

New York State Department of Taxation and Finance may be sending letters, requesting additional income information. Please do not ignore their request. If you have concerns, please feel free to call or come visit our office.

Exemption Renewals will be mailed out at their appropriate time.

**SALES MARKET** - Residents in the Town of Lockport are very fortunate to continually have increasing property values/sales. For those not following our sales market, homes have been selling over assessed value, with many 20 to 60% over their assessment. Here's the BUT, we need to be prepared for increased assessments. Please keep in mind, assessments are estimated values, based on sales market, AND have nothing to do with tax rates. Ask yourself, “If I were to sell my house today, what can I get for it?”

# Highway Department



**Brush Pick Up:** Brush pick up will continue until the 3rd Monday of November. Please have your brush out by Sunday night. Please remember we pick up throughout the town. If for some reason we don't pick up your brush on Monday, leave it out and we will get to it.

**Garbage/Recycling:** Please have your garbage and recycling out by 6 a.m. Please be patient if your garbage/recycling hasn't been picked up. The reason could be anything from the truck breaking down to the trucks having to be dumped. If you haven't been picked up by 3 p.m., please call the highway office at 439-9522. The highway clerk will contact our representative from Waste Management and find out what happened. Also, please remember Waste Management has only the following holidays off: Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Memorial Day and July 4th.

**Large Item Pick Up:** Please remember you may put out one (1) large item per week with your garbage. This includes: refrigerators, freezers, mattresses, box springs & furniture. If Waste Management doesn't take it with your garbage, leave it out and they will be back within a day or two.

**Winter Snow Removal Reminders:** \*\*No parking on town roads from Nov. 1st – April 1st from 1 am – 7 am. \*\*State Law: no one is permitted to push snow across the road or deposit snow in the roadway with either a plow, snow blower or shovel. Residents who hire outside contractors for this service are asked to remind them of this law. Tickets may be issued for offenders.

\*\*Please do not tailgate trucks as they sometimes have to back up at some intersections.

\*\*Mailboxes are never damaged intentionally. Please call the highway office for repairs or replacement, 439-9522.

**NOTE:** only standard mailboxes and steel posts are used for replacement. If you have an expensive and/or decorative mailbox, you may want to consider replacing it for the winter.

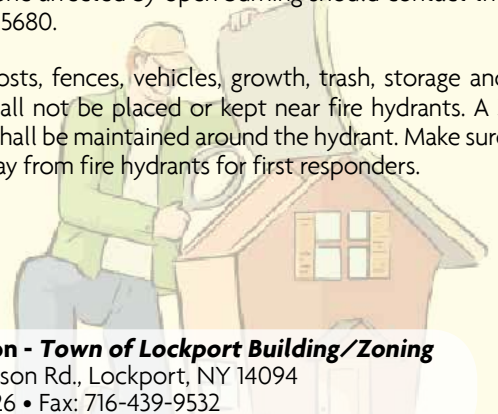

## NOTE FROM BUILDING INSPECTOR

**Open Burning NYSDEC:** Open burning is permitted in small recreational fires including small cooking and campfires. Burning of waste product garbage is prohibited. Newspaper, paper, plastic, chemically treated wood and plywood is prohibited. Campfires less than 3 feet in height and 4 feet in length, width or diameter are allowed. Anyone affected by open burning should contact the DEC at 1-877-457-5680.

**Fire Hydrants:** Posts, fences, vehicles, growth, trash, storage and other material shall not be placed or kept near fire hydrants. A 3 foot clear space shall be maintained around the hydrant. Make sure to clear snow away from fire hydrants for first responders.

## Travels Through Town

Did you know the most common street name in New York State is Park, followed by Maple, Lake, and Sunset? Roads are often named for distinguishing features or landmarks--natural or manmade. People are also a frequent namesake, presidents being a popular choice.

In Lockport, many of our roads are named after early settlers. A person's home or farm would be a distinctive feature so it is understandable a road would become known by the name of a prominent or pioneer resident.

Some examples of roads and their namesakes are:

**Crosby Road:** E. Ellis Crosby (1857-1936) purchased a 125 acre farm in 1882 on what is now known as Crosby Road.

**Day Road:** Loring Parker Day (1794-1870) purchased almost 100 acres in 1834. His son, Charles Leete Day, and grandson, George Wilcox Day, later ran the farm which was known as Elm Brook Farm. George, a Cornell graduate, patented the first orchard tractor.

**Hinman Road:** Charles Hinman (1799-1867), originally from Saratoga, N.Y., bought 200 acres from the Holland Land Company in 1835.

**Keck Road:** Stephen Keck (1790-1871), a farmer from Pennsylvania, purchased 92 acres in 1834 and then 125 acres the following year. During the 1840s, he acquired an additional 300+ acres. His sons acquired land as well and they each managed farms on their extensive property.

**Leete Road:** Epaphras Nott Leete (1789-1872), a War of 1812 veteran, purchased 200 acres in 1839 on what is now the intersection of Sunset Drive and Leete Road.

**Purdy Road:** Benjamin Erastus Purdy (1803-1874), originally from Vermont, travelled to Lockport and acquired 147 acres in 1834.

**Ruhlmann Road:** In 1870, French immigrant Arbogaste Ruhlmann (1817-1892) bought land on what is now Ruhlmann Road. He managed a market gardening business with his son, Eugene.

**Wick Road:** The Wick family acquired land on this road in 1893. Patriarch Gregorius and his sons

August, Jacob, and Henry were all neighbors. Descendants still live on the road today.

And there are many, many more! Bartz, Bowmiller, Dysinger, Ernest, Hamm, Kinne, Raymond, Wynkoop—the list goes on. The Historian's Office is compiling histories on the families and roads named after them. In the Lockport Union Sun & Journal, there is a series on the roads called Travels Through Town. Check it out to learn more about our town's history.
