Local Law No. 5 of the year 2011

A local law relative to amending the Lockport City Code C-12 Term of elective officers

Be it enacted by the Common Council of the City of Lockport as follows:

C-12. Term of elective officers

The terms of elective officers shall be as follows: Mayor, City Treasurer, four years; Councilman, two years; City Judge, six years.

No person shall be eligible to be elected to or serve in the office of mayor if that person had previously held such office for two or more full consecutive terms, unless one full term or more has elapsed since that person last held such office; provided, however, that in calculating the number of consecutive terms a person has served, only terms commencing on or after January 1, 2014 shall be counted.

No person shall be eligible to be elected to or serve in the office of council member if that person had previously held such office for three or more full consecutive terms, unless one full term or more has elapsed since that person last held such office; provided, however, that in calculating the number of consecutive terms a person has served, only terms commencing on or after January 1, 2014 shall be counted.
