

AGREEMENT

This Agreement made this 1 day of JUNE, 2012, by and between **LOCKPORT COMMUNITY BAND**, c/o 273 Lock Street, Lockport, NY (hereinafter referred to as the "Band") and the **TOWN OF LOCKPORT**, on behalf of the **TOWN OF LOCKPORT RECREATION COMMISSION**, with its principal office located at 6560 Dysinger Road, Lockport, New York (hereinafter referred to as "the Town").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Band is a full ensemble concert band and has agreed to perform a concert for the Town of Lockport on July 22, 2012, at the Lockport Community Day, and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to contract with the Band to perform this concert,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED:

1. That the Lockport Community Band shall perform a concert on July 22, 2012, from 2:00 p.m. until 3:30 p.m. at the Lockport Community Day, at Lockport Town Hall, 6560 Dysinger Road, Lockport, New York.

2. In consideration thereof the Town shall pay the Lockport Community Band the amount of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.

3. In the event of the need to reschedule or cancel due to inclement weather, the Town agrees to give the Band a minimum of three hours notice of such rescheduling or cancellation.


4. The Town of Lockport further agrees to provide the appropriate seating and sound system as required by the Band for the concert.
