Such law will require a permit to be issued for all professional fireworks displays and will limit the number of such displays to two performances per year per applicant.

**LOCAL LAW NO. \_\_\_ OF THE YEAR 2021**

**TOWN OF LOCKPORT**

**COUNTY OF NIAGARA, STATE OF NEW YORK**

**A Local Law Amending Chapter 123, Noise, to Include Certain Restrictions on the Permitting of Fireworks Displays**

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Lockport as follows:

The Town of Lockport Code, as contained in Chapter 123 of the Code of the Town of Lockport, is hereby amended as follows:

- 1) Section 123-3 is hereby amended to the following:

No person shall cause or permit to be caused any noise which can be heard by a person with normal hearing beyond the boundaries of property owned, leased or otherwise controlled by him, or upon which he is located, that shall unreasonably disturb, alarm or interfere with the comfort, repose or peace of other persons, except as otherwise permitted by this chapter.

- 2) Section 123 is hereby amended to include Section 123 – 6 Fireworks as follows:

**§ 123 – 6 Fireworks**

- A. No person or entity shall engage in a firework display unless they obtain a permit from the Building Department upon a form to be furnished by the Town consistent with the requirements set forth in § 405 of the New York State Penal Law. A permit fee as determined by the Town Board by resolution shall be charged for such permit. The statutory bond, or insurance of not less than \$1,000,000, shall be required for the permit to issue.
- B. Applications for permits. An application for a permit shall be in writing on a form provided by or otherwise acceptable to the Code Enforcement Officer. Such application shall include such information as the Code Enforcement Officer deems sufficient to permit a determination by the Code Enforcement Officer that quantities, materials, and activities conform to the requirements pursuant to § 405.00 of the New York State Penal Law.
- C. Limitation on issuance of permits. There shall be no more than two fireworks display permits issued by the Code Enforcement Officer for any parcel, or series of adjacent parcels, which are owned, leased, or otherwise under the control of the same person or entity, as determined by the Code Enforcement Officer, for the period of one year, as measured from the beginning of the calendar year.
