

April 2, 2012

A regularly scheduled work session of the Lockport Town Board was conducted at 1:05 p.m. on Monday, April 2, 2012, at the Town Hall, 6560 Dysinger Road, Lockport, New York.

Supervisor Smith opened the meeting as follows:

1. **Town Clerk** – Nothing to report.
2. **Attorney** – Not present.
3. **Engineer** – Nothing to report.
4. **Town Board Comments**

*Councilwoman Antkowiak* reported that she continues to work with the Dale Association on the upcoming Health Fair that will cover “senior issues” like medical insurance, Medicare etc. The event will be held at the Dale Association as they are better equipped to handle the event.

She also continues to work with Rob Klavoon on the plans for a pavilion at Day Road Park as well as with the representatives of Challenger Sports on the upcoming summer sports program.

*Councilman Pettit* commented that the brick work being completed on the Day Road Park restrooms is going very slowly. He also stated that had he believed the stone work was unnecessary and that if he had known that the plans called for such work, he would not have voted in favor of the plans. Supervisor Smith stated that all Board members were given the plans to review before any action was taken to approve them. Councilman Crocker also commented that the restrooms are still being built under budget and both he and Supervisor Smith stated that they wanted the building to have nice esthetics to add to the appeal of the park.

*Councilman Siejak* reported that Ken Banker informed him that the Town Water Dept. was recently notified of an increase in the cost of water meters. The Town is currently charging less than they are being billed for and he requested that the Town Board review this information for action at a later date. Supervisor Smith agreed and stated that the information will be gathered and forwarded to the Town Board for corrective measures as soon as possible.

5. **Supervisor's Comments**

WNY Land Conservancy – Supervisor Smith reported that the Conservancy is looking to conduct a “Natural Garden & Backyard Habitat Tour” at the Lytle Nature Preserve on July 8, 2012 at 1, 3 & 5:00 p.m. This would be a regional tour (one of six sites planned for visitation on that date) to help promote the work being done at Lytle Nature Preserve. Mr. Ken Horvath would be available for the showings on that date to help with any questions that visitors might have. He stated that he thought this was a nice way to highlight the accomplishments and improvements that have taken place at the preserve.

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Councilman Pettit asked what can be done about the ticks in the Preserve as this year is expected to have a very heavy infestation of such pests. Supervisor Smith answered that the Land Conservancy is aware and will surely accommodate visitors on that matter.

**6. Executive Session Entered**

**MOTION (2012-63):** to enter Executive Session to discuss the job performance of a particular person was made by Council member Antkowiak, seconded by Council member Crocker. The motion was CARRIED: AYES - 5, NAYS - 0. Voting AYE: Antkowiak, Pettit, Crocker, Siejak and Smith.

The Town Board entered Executive Session at 1:08 p.m.

**7. Executive Session Ended and Work Session Reconvened**

**MOTION (2012-64):** to exit Executive Session and to reconvene the work session was made by Council member Siejak, seconded by Council member Pettit. The motion was CARRIED: AYES - 5, NAYS - 0. Voting AYE: Antkowiak, Pettit, Crocker, Siejak and Smith.


The work session was reconvened at 1:25 p.m. with no Town Board action taken during Executive Session.
