

4. Town Board Reports/Comments

Councilman Siejak stated he has spoken with the Town Highway Dept. with regard to brush pickup. Their normal brush pickup schedule begins in March, however, due to current weather conditions; they will begin as soon as the weather permits. The Clerk's office will advise residents accordingly.

5. Supervisor's Reports/Comments

Niagara Regional Surgery Center on Transit Road – He reminded Board members that they will be having their grand opening (2-7:00 p.m.) and ribbon cutting at 5:30 p.m. this evening, March 2, 2015.

Eastern Niagara Chamber of Commerce - Supervisor Smith and Economic Development Director, David Kinyon, attended the annual dinner. The Supervisor stated that Yahoo, Inc. was awarded "Business of the Year" and two other businesses honored were all from the Lockport area, which he felt was a very positive thing.

Street Lighting – Supervisor Smith stated he has been in contact with Lou Poennesa of N.I.P.A. to investigate the possibility of upgrading some of the Town's street lights to the energy efficient LED lights, rather than the current 300 watt sodium lights. He will keep the Board informed of any progress in this matter.
