### From the Supervisor's Desk:

I wanted to take a moment to summarize the recent changes to the garbage/recycling contract so that we are all on the same page. In the fall of 2022, our current refuse provider, Waste Management, let us know that they would not be offering an extension of our current contract which was scheduled to end on 12/31/22. With a tight window and no time to waste, the town board moved swiftly to put the contract out for bid as required for service of this type.

I understand that change is difficult, but in this case, necessary and beyond our control. These changes actually translate to savings to you. To start with, the Modern Bid was \$80 per year less than the next bidder. In addition, the rate per household is \$228.64 in 2023 then moves down to \$220.95 for the remainder of the 6 year contract as a result of only requiring one person in the truck instead of two as we move to the carts. There is an increase of up to 3% per year built into the contract for inflation.

When we opened the bids from two providers, Modern Disposal was the low bidder for the six (6) year contract covering the years 2023-2028. The town did not have options on some of the services. I would like to take this opportunity to walk you through where we are as of today, and where we will be as we move through the contract years.

### Listed below are the key points which should answer any questions you may have.

There will be no change to your service pick up day for both garbage and recycling. Please see the updated Modern schedule on page 3 of this publication.

For the remainder of 2023, you will still be able to put out (6) bags per week weighing no more than 45 lbs each.

On 1/1/24, the town will be required to change over to cart only pick up for the garbage moving forward (just like the one you currently have for recycling).

Each homeowner will be issued one (1) 96 gallon cart with the Town of Lockport colors and logo on the front which will be delivered to your home in the Fall of 2023.

Instead of one large item each week on your regular garbage day, you may put out FOUR large items with your regular garbage once a month. Please see the schedule on page 3 for the BULK COLLECTION WEEK which is the gray tab on the left side. This was the only option offered by the service provider.

This method of pick up has been the trend in collection and hauling of municipal solid waste throughout the nation. The cart will prevent injuries and increase efficiency with mechanical arms directed by the truck driver.

The initial supply of 96 gallon garbage carts will be delivered to the town in the Fall of 2023. The one time associated fee of \$65 will be added to your County Tax Bill in January of 2024.

If you believe you'll need more than the one issued to you, additional quantities will be available to you at a cost of \$65 each with Modern charging an additional \$33.75 service charge per cart/per year for the extra container. If a resident

needs extra capacity beyond the cart, Modern will sell additional bag tags for \$5 each. These tags will allow you to place an addition bag/item out, not to exceed 45lbs, with your normal trash day.

### TOWN OF LOCKPORT ELECTRONICS RECYCLING SHED REOPENS IN MARCH!

I know it's not nearly as exciting as when the paving list comes out, but...it's nearly time for the electronics recycling shed to open for the season! With that said, I would like to answer a few of the common questions we get while working these events.

#### What do you accept at the event?

Think of going into the electronics section of a big box store. What do you see? TVs, DVD players, computers, monitors, laptops, cell phones right? These are the things we are looking to recycle. See the list below for details...

#### What do you NOT accept at this event?

Household appliances such as vacuums, stick vacuums, microwaves, fans, hair dryers, toasters and the like. These items should be put out on your regular garbage day for Modern to take. The recycle company does not find value in the minimal electronic components in these items. Also, NO BATTERIES of any type.

**The hours of operation for the Town of Lockport Recycling Shed are: The last Saturday of each month, 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM, March 25th through November. NO after hour drop-offs will be permitted. Cameras are in place to protect and enforce the program. This event is open to Town of Lockport residents only (please be prepared to show ID).**

Just a reminder that we CANNOT accept broken or bare CRT TVs or batteries. The TV must be in tact with the shell and all in order for us to take it.

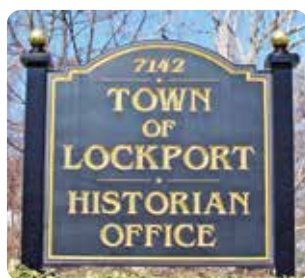

# Town Historian



## Happy 199th birthday to our town

Happy birthday to the Town of Lockport! Our town was officially established 199 years ago on February 2nd, 1823. Next year, the Town will be celebrating the big 200!

Lockport's formation is intertwined with the Erie Canal. When the exact route of the Canal was determined, a village began to develop in what is now the City of Lockport. With the village quickly progressing, it needed a name. Inspired by the elaborate set of locks which were to be constructed, Surveyor Jesse Haines suggested the name Locksborough for this new village. Dr. Isaac Smith countered with the name Lockport. Residents discussed the names and, unsurprisingly to those of us today, they chose the name Lockport.

Construction of the flight of five locks began in 1821. Lockport had a name and a purpose, but it was not officially incorporated as a municipality. In the Journal of the Assembly of the State of New York, Forty-Seventh Session, January 1824, it was claimed that "the sundry inhabitants of Cambria and Royalton [are] praying for the erection of a town by the name of Lockport." Their prayers were answered. On February 2, 1824, the Town of Lockport was officially established from the eastern section of Cambria and western portion of Royalton.

As we are planning for this bicentennial which kicks off next year, we need your help getting ready. In order to make this the grandest celebration the town has ever seen, we would love to hear from you! What are your favorite memories of Lockport? Are there stories passed down by your family about the town or its residents? Do you have photographs, documents, or artifacts you would be willing to donate or loan? We can scan your materials and return the originals to you.

One of the exhibits we would like to present is a history of the town schools. We have historic photos of many of them, but not all. Do you or your family have photos of the schools? Please reach out. We are especially looking for historic photos of: District 6 (Akron Road at Wynkoop, cobblestone), District 11 (Harrington, brick), District 13 (Ridge, east of Purdy, brick), and District 14 (East High Street, plank).

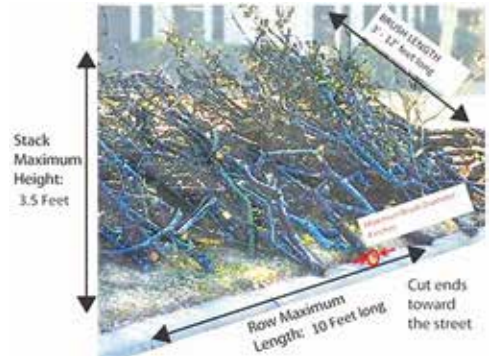

**Brush Pick Up:** We will resume brush pick the week of March 19th and it will be the third Monday of each month until November. **The following rules will be enforced for the town wide brush pick-up:**

- Tree removal companies are to remove all of their own debris.
- A maximum amount of one tandem truckload will be picked up at a time at any one residence.
- No brush will be picked up that is stacked around hydrants, guardrails, vent pipes, signs, or any obstacle. We will not be responsible for anything under the pile of brush that we cannot see. Large piles are picked up with large machinery.



**Yard Damage:** If your yard has been damaged by our snow plow, please call the highway office. The highway clerk will take your information & we will fix any damages when the weather is better.

### FROM THE ASSESSOR'S OFFICE



#### Annual Re-Assessment Program

The Town of Lockport is continuing on its 22nd year of annual re-assessment, to maintain its equalization level at 100% of market value. All properties in the town are analyzed. Any changes are determined by recent sale information.

Change of Assessment Notices are mailed around the first week of April. Any physical changes to the property, including additions, garages, pole barns, sheds, decks and demolition of structures; may also affect the assessments. Please review these notices. Informal meetings with the assessor are available in April, by appointment. Formal challenges to the assessments can be scheduled for the Board of Assessment Review on or before, Tuesday, May 23, 2023, by appointment.

### NOTE FROM BUILDING INSPECTOR

#### Burning Ban:

The start of Spring in New York comes with an increased risk of wildfires. For this reason, there is a burning ban in all of NYS from March 16, 2023 until May 14, 2023. NYS prohibits residential brush burning to protect our communities and natural resources. If you would like to report a violation, please contact the NYS DEC directly at 1-877-457-5680. There are representatives to take your call 24 hours a day.

#### Backyard fire pits and campfires:

Less than 3 feet in height and four feet in length, width or diameter are allowed along with small cooking fires. Only charcoal or dry, clean, untreated, or unpainted wood can be burned.

#### Permit Requirements:

Permits are required for ALL swimming pools, home backup generators, siding, roofing and deck projects. 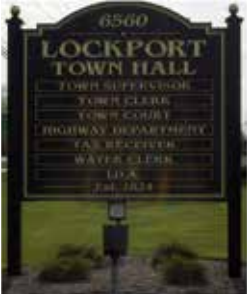
