

NOTE FROM: The Dog Control Officer

NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets requires that all dogs four (4) months and older with a current rabies vaccination be licensed.

FEE SCHEDULE:

(Must be renewed annually at the Town Clerk's office)

Spayed/neutered dog - \$8.00

Non-spayed/non-neutered dog - \$18.00

The Dog Control Officer's duties include enforcement of dog licensing and ordinances.

Dogs must be effectively restricted or controlled by a person or a leash not exceeding 15 feet in length. Since it is the law, KEEP ID TAGS ON YOUR DOGS AT ALL TIMES.

NEED TO GET YOUR HUNTING OR FISHING LICENSE?

Conservation Licenses may be purchased at the Town Clerk's office located at 6560 Dysinger Road during regular business hours. You can contact the Clerk's office at 439-9524 with any questions prior to your visit. **To purchase a hunting license you must have completed the proper hunter safety course and present your certificate.** Please visit www.dec.gov for any further information or clarification.

You need a hunting license if you are:

- 12 years and older and using a firearm or bow to hunt or take wild game. Persons under age 12 cannot hunt
- Annual hunting licenses and privileges are valid from September 1 through August 31 each year.

• All licensed hunters 12 and older can apply for deer permits as well.

You need a fishing license if you are 16 years and older

 Fishing licenses do not require a training course and expire one year from date of purchase or renewal.



ANNUAL MEDICARE INFORMATION MEETING

Need help navigating the Medicare process? I am pleased to announce that the Town of Lockport will be hosting a Medicare Information Night on *Thursday*, *October 26th from 5:30 pm - 7:30 pm. at Town Hall*, 6560 *Dysinger Rd*. This event will be held in collaboration with the Dale Association and the Niagara County Office for the Aging.

It will be informal and held in an open forum setting. You will receive information regarding the changes to Medicare, the Medicare Health Plans, Medicare Part D, NYS EPIC, and "Extra Help", the Low Income Subsidy program. Attendees will be able to meet one on one with various representatives and providers.

- Medicare Open Enrollment Period is October 15th 2023 December 7th 2023
- **Turning 65?** Your Initial Enrollment Period for Medicare Part A & B is based on the month in which you turn 65. It begins three months before your birth month and extends until three months after your birth month. Example: If you are born on June 18, 1959, your Initial Enrollment Period is from March 1, 2024 until September 30, 2024.

I encourage anyone approaching the age of 65 to attend. Medicare can be extremely confusing and we must always remember that *knowledge is power*. I look forward to seeing you on October 26th!

LAST CHANCE FOR ELECTRONICS RECYCLING FOR 2023!

Come on out to see us on **Saturday, October 28th** and again on **Saturday, November 25th** to get those electronics properly recycled. This is your last opportunity for the year, otherwise you'll need to hold on to these items until March of 2024. As you know, this event is held right at Town Hall from 9 am – 1 pm. No need to get out of the vehicle, just pull up and we will do the rest.

Recycling electronics costs the town up to 9 cents a pound. Since we are not charging a fee for this service, we are limiting usage strictly to **Town of Lockport Residents** (please be prepared to show ID).

The hours of operation for the Town of Lockport Recycling Shed are: The last Saturday of each month, 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM, March through November. NO after hour drop-offs will be permitted. Cameras are in place to protect and enforce the program.

ACCEPTABLE ELECTRONIC RECYCLING LIST

- Televisions (CRT, LCD, LED, PLASMA, 3D)
- Computer Monitors (CRT, LCD, LED)
- Computers (Desktops & Laptops)
- Printers (Ink or Toner)
- Microwave Ovens
- Copiers/Fax Machines
- Video Equipment (VCR, DVD & Video Cameras)

Limit 4 large items (TV's) per month, open to Town of Lockport residents only.

NOTE FROM BUILDING INSPECTOR

Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detector: Now is a good time to replace batteries in smoke and carbon monoxide detectors going into the fall and winter season. Smoke/CO detectors should be replaced after 10 years of use with new 10-year battery smoke/CO detectors.

Fire Hydrants: Fire Code of NYS: A 3 foot clear space shall be maintained around the circumference of a fire hydrant.

Premise Identification: New and existing buildings shall have approved address numbers, building numbers or approved building identification plainly legible and visible from the street. Numbers shall be a minimum of 4 inches.

INCOME LIMIT CHANGE FOR ENHANCED STAR

If you are currently receiving the BASIC STAR EXEMPTION, and **will be turning 65** by December 31, 2024, you could be eligible for ENHANCED STAR.

The income limit for the 2024-2025 school tax year is \$98,700, as verified by the 2022 Federal or State Income Tax Return. Income is Adjusted Gross MINUS any Taxable IRA Distributions. State Form IT-201 (Line 19 Minus 9) and Federal Form 1040 (Line 7 Minus the IRA Distribution).

ALL Enhanced STAR Exemption recipients, **MUST** apply to the IVP (Income Verification Program). **Even if you don't file tax returns.** If you do not file income tax returns, Form RP-425-wkst must be completed.

You must meet the income and residency requirements; and must apply by March 1, 2024.

Refuse/Recycling: Please have your garbage and recycling out by 6 am. If it still isn't picked up by 3 pm, call the highway office and the clerk will try to find out what the issue is. Also, please remember Modern Disposal only has the following holidays off: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving & Christmas.

Please remember large item pick up is the first FULL week of the month. If a holiday falls on a Monday of the first full week of the month, large item pick up will be the following week.


Example: January 1st, New Year's Day, falls on a Monday and it is the first full week of the month. Therefore, large item pick up will be the week of January 8th. You are allowed 4 large items.

Pool Liners: must be rolled up, tied and cut down to 4' in length.

Dead Animals: If you have a dead animal on or near your property, please call Nicholas Fleckenstein at 716-628-1879 or email him at niagaralage@gmail.com. He will pick up small animals (raccoons, fox, or anything that size or smaller). He does charge a fee. The Town of Lockport only picks up dead deer on town roads.

Brush Pick-Up: Brush pick up is the third Monday of the month from March - November. November will be the last month for 2023. Please have your brush out by Sunday night. We pick up throughout the whole town. If you don't have it out by the time we come around, you will have to wait until the next month. **The following rules will be enforced for the town wide brush pick-up:**

- Tree removal companies are to remove all of their own debris
- A maximum amount of one tandem truckload will be picked up at time at any one residence.
- No brush will be picked up that is stacked around hydrants, guardrails, vent pipes, signs, or any obstacle. We will not be responsible for anything under the pile of brush that we cannot see. Large piles are picked up with large machinery.
