From the Supervisor's Desk: Welcome 2024

As we enter the new year, I'd like to focus on our new garbage cart program. The initial rollout of the cart program in December went very smoothly. We distributed over 6,300 carts to homes and businesses. We did receive complaints about the lids not closing completely. This was because they were newly manufactured carts and the plastic cart lids needed to "relax" and within 2 weeks the cart lids fit perfectly.

The Town of Lockport sent large postcards explaining the program to everyone included in the Refuse District. Residential garbage and recycling pickup days stayed the same. Large item pickup remains the first full week of each month. If there is a holiday in the first week, it means large items pickup will be the following week on your regular garbage day. You may put up to 4 large items each month.

Residential service this year is \$225 per home/business. This includes both the refuse and recycling programs. The first cart you received through the new program was paid for by the Town of Lockport. If you require an additional cart, the cost is an additional \$50 per year service charge (added to your spring County tax bill), plus a one time charge for the cart (\$65). Each homeowner can have up to 4 carts before they're charged an additional \$225. If you require additional carts, please come into Town Hall and visit the Clerk's Office. After we receive payment, we will deliver the additional units to your home.

If you no longer need your old garbage carts/cans, please place an X on the front of the container and place it out with your regular garbage. Please make sure it is empty. Also, please do not get rid of your recycling cart (yellow lid). You will need it for our recycling program.

Lastly, we know that change is sometimes difficult. The companies that bid on our refuse contract did not give us any option to stay with our past 6 bag/can pickup program. We thank you for your patience and understanding. This transition to carts is the wave of

the future, and as you drive around Western New York, you will notice that every town and city have transitioned to cart based pickup. It is safer for the refuse workers, and it helps to keep Town refuse prices down going forward.

TOWN OF LOCKPORT ELECTRONICS RECYCLING SHED REOPENS IN APRIL!

I know it's not nearly as exciting as when the paving list comes out, but...it's nearly time for the electronics recycling shed to open for the season! With that said, I would like to answer a few of the common questions we get while working these events.

What do you accept at the event?

Think of going into the electronics section of a big box store. What do you see? TVs, DVD players, computers, monitors, laptops, cell phones right? These are the things we are looking to recycle. See the list below for details...

What do you NOT accept at this event?

Household appliances such as vacuums, stick vacuums, microwaves, fans, hair dryers, toasters and the like. These items should be put out on your regular garbage day for Modern to take. The recycle company does not find value in the minimal electronic components in these items. Also, NO BATTERIES of any type.

The hours of operation for the Town of Lockport Recycling Shed are: The last Saturday of each month, 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM, April through October. NO after hour drop-offs will be permitted. Cameras are in place to protect and enforce the program. This event is open to Town of Lockport residents only (please be prepared to show ID).

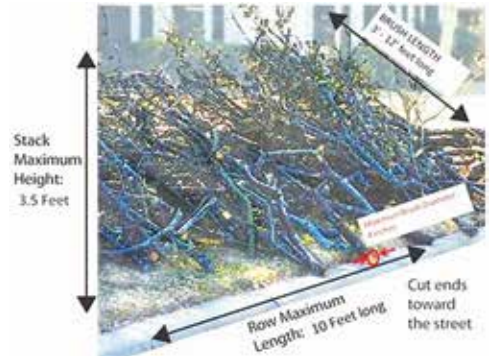


Highway Department



Brush Pick Up: We will resume brush pick the week of March 18th and it will be the third Monday of each month until November. **The following rules will be enforced for the town wide brush pick-up:**

- Tree removal companies are to remove all of their own debris.
- A maximum amount of one tandem truckload will be picked up at a time at any one residence.
- No brush will be picked up that is stacked around hydrants, guardrails, vent pipes, signs, or any obstacle. We will not be responsible for anything under the pile of brush that we cannot see. Large piles are picked up with large machinery.



Yard Damage: If your yard has been damaged by our snow plow, please call the highway office. The highway clerk will take your information & we will fix any damages when the weather is better.

Annual Re-Assessment Program

The Town of Lockport is continuing on its 23rd year of annual re-assessment, to maintain its equalization level at 100% of market value. All properties in the Town are analyzed. Any changes are determined by recent sale information.

Change of Assessment Notices are mailed around the first week of April. Any physical changes to the property, including additions, garages, pole barns, sheds, decks and demolition of structures; may also affect the assessments. Please review these notices. Informal meetings with the assessor are available in April, by appointment. Formal challenges to the assessments can be scheduled for the Board of Assessment Review on or before, Tuesday, May 28, 2024, by appointment.

NOTE FROM BUILDING INSPECTOR

Burning Ban:

The start of Spring in New York comes with an increased risk of wildfires. For this reason, there is a burning ban in all of NYS from **March 16, 2024 until May 14, 2024**. NYS prohibits residential brush burning to protect our communities and natural resources. If you would like to report a violation, please contact the NYS DEC directly at 1-877-457-5680. There are representatives to take your call 24 hours a day.

Backyard fire pits and campfires:

Less than 3 feet in height and four feet in length, width or diameter are allowed along with small cooking fires. Only charcoal or dry, clean, untreated, or unpainted wood can be burned.

Permit Requirements:

Permits are required for ALL swimming pools, home backup generators, siding, roofing and deck projects. Applications can be obtained at the Building Department located at 6200 Robinson Rd or visit our website at www.elockport.com for more information along with access to the applications.
