Welcome to Summer in the Town of Lockport! I'd like to take a moment to clarify some things based on recent feedback relative to the cart based garbage cart program. I'm hoping to get the word out to the 10% of our residents who haven't heard that we are now a customer of Modern Corporation. Our initial roll-out of the cart program in December of 2023 went very smoothly. We distributed over 6,300 units to homes and businesses.

The Town of Lockport sent large postcards explaining the program to everyone included in the Refuse District. In addition to that, Modern Corporation sent out an information package explaining the new cart based trash collection system.

The basics are as follows:

- Residential garbage and recycling pickup days remain the same.
- Large item pickup is the first full week of each month. If there is a holiday in the first week, it means large items pickup will be the following week on your regular garbage day. You may put up to four (4) large items each month.

Residential service this year cost \$225 per home/ business. This includes both the refuse and

recycling programs. The first cart you received through the new program was paid for by the

Town of Lockport. If you require another cart, the cost is an additional \$50 per year service charge (added to your spring County tax bill), plus a one time charge for the cart (\$65). Each homeowner can have up to 4 carts before they are charged an additional \$225. If you require additional carts, please come into Town Hall and visit the Clerk's Office. After payment in full, we will deliver the carts to your home. If you do not feel you routinely need extra capacity, we can sell you a \$5 tag (made available through Modern Disposal) at the Clerk's Office which is placed on the additional bags of garbage.

Lastly, we know that change is sometimes difficult. The companies that bid on our refuse contract did not give us any option to stay with our past 6 bag/ can pickup program. We thank you for your patience and understanding. This transition to carts is the wave of the future. As you drive around Western New York, you will notice that every town and city have transitioned to cart based pickup. It is safer for the refuse workers, and it helps to keep Town refuse prices down going forward.

2024 Household Hazardous Waste & Paper Shredding Event Coming Soon!

Niagara County and the Town of Lockport are teaming up to host a combination household hazardous waste and paper shredding event on <u>Saturday</u>, July 13th from 9:00 am until noon at the highway garage located at 6560 Dysinger Road. Pre-registration is required for the Household Hazardous Waste portion and will be made available 30 days prior to the event.

Household Hazardous Waste:

- Residents are encouraged to bring paint and unwanted cleaners, chemical and automotive fluids to the event. You MUST register for this event!!!
- Simply go to <u>www.rethinkyourwaste.com/events</u> and scroll down to the Town of Lockport event. There is also a list of items that will be accepted for recycling posted on that website.

Shredding:

- Bring any confidential paper items you would like shredded
- Limit of 10 bags, boxes or totes per residence
- Please remove binder clips and any metal items such as hanging file folders as they clog up the equipment
- Your items will be put in the shredder on site
- Pre-registration is NOT required if you are only bringing shredding!

NOTE FROM BUILDING INSPECTOR

NYSDEC: Open burning is permitted for small recreational fires including small cooking and campfires. Burning of waste products or garbage is prohibited, including newspaper, paper products, plastic, chemically treated wood (pressure treated) and plywood. Complaints call NYS DEC @ 1-877-457-5680. They are available 24/7

Swimming Pool Fencing & Alarm Requirements: NYS mandates that ALL swimming pools, residential or commercial, permanent or temporary (blue soft sided) are required to be in fenced enclosures 48" high and equipped with audible alarm.

Required Building Permits: Permits are required for roofing, siding, decks and swimming pools 24" deep or greater.


Highway Department



Brush pick up weeks are July 15th, August 19th, and September 16th. Please have it to the road Sunday night. We pick up throughout the whole town. If you don't have it

out by the time we come around, you will have to wait until the next month. Please refer to our guidelines on our website at elockport.com under highway department.

Refuse/Recycling: Please have your garbage and recycling out by 6 am. If it isn't picked up by 2 pm, call the highway clerk at 716-439-9522. Please remember you must use the town issued garbage tote. No other tote will be emptied.



Bags of Garbage: If you have bags which are over forty pounds, Modern will

pick them up during large item pick up week. If they are less than forty pounds, you will need to purchase stickers from town clerk's office for \$5 each.

Old Garbage Cans: If you have a garbage tote with a bar the truck can lift, you may put it out on your regular garbage day, with an "X" on it, and Modern will take it away. If it **DOES NOT** have a bar, please put it out during *large item week*, with an "X", and Modern will take it. They **WILL NOT** take them with garbage inside.

Bulk Pick Up: Modern will pick up 4 large items during the first full week of each month. If they don't take it with the regular garbage truck, please be patient and they will come back with another truck. This includes any carpet/flooring/wood planks you may have.

Hazardous Materials: If you have anything hazardous and are unsure of how to dispose of it, please call Hazman at 716-998-8073.

Road Work: As the weather is getting warmer, please be cautious when our crews are milling/paving. We ask that you obey flagmen and detour signs the ensure safety. Visit our Facebook page, website at elockport.com or watch the LED sign at Town Hall for roadwork updates.
