Recycling Program Update

As a result of the diligent efforts by our residents, the Town of Lockport is on track to save nearly \$130,000 over the first two years of our contract with Modern Disposal. The market values for recycled commodities, such as cardboard and paper, have steadily increased along with the quantity of those materials we are all placing in our recycling carts. This is very welcome news as recycling, in general, has struggled in years past to produce tangible cost savings. The money the Town of Lockport saves from a successful recycling program goes right back into the

refuse fund line in our budget. These additional funds help offset increases in annual expenses.

Bottom line: Recycling does pay and helps the environment at the same time. We thank you for your efforts and encourage you to continue to break down boxes and place all acceptable items in the cart with the yellow lid. Remember, the items to be recycled need to be clean and limited to what is included on the graphic.

ANNUAL MEDICARE INFORMATION MEETING

Need help navigating the Medicare process? I am pleased to announce that the Town of Lockport will be hosting a Medicare Information Night on *Tuesday*, *October 29th from 5:00 pm - 7:00 pm. at Town Hall*, *6560 Dysinger Rd*. This event will be held in collaboration with the Dale Association and the Niagara County Office for the Aging.

It will be informal and held in an open forum setting. You will receive information regarding the changes to Medicare, the Medicare Health Plans, Medicare Part D, NYS EPIC, and "Extra Help", the Low Income Subsidy program. Attendees will be able to meet one on one with various representatives and providers.

- Medicare Open Enrollment Period is October 15th 2024 – December 7th 2024
- **Turning 65?** Your Initial Enrollment Period for Medicare Part A & B is based on the month in which you turn 65. It begins three months before your birth month and extends until three months after your birth month. Example: If you are born on June 18, 1960, your Initial Enrollment Period is from March 1, 2024 until September 30, 2025.

I encourage anyone approaching the age of 65 to attend. Medicare can be extremely confusing and we must always remember that **knowledge is power**. I look forward to seeing you on October 29th!

NEED TO GET YOUR HUNTING OR FISHING LICENSE?

Conservation Licenses may be purchased at the Town Clerk's office located at 6560 Dysinger Road during regular business hours. You can contact the Clerk's office at 439-9524 with any questions prior to your visit. To purchase a hunting license you must have completed the proper hunter safety course and present your certificate. Please visit www.dec.gov for any further information or clarification.

You need a hunting license if you are:

- 12 years and older and using a firearm or bow to hunt or take wild game. Persons under age 12 cannot hunt
- Annual hunting licenses and privileges are valid from September 1 through August 31 each year.

• All licensed hunters 12 and older can apply for deer permits as well.

You need a fishing license if you are 16 years and older

 Fishing licenses do not require a training course and expire one year from date of purchase or renewal.

INCOME LIMIT CHANGE FOR ENHANCED STAR

If you are currently receiving the BASIC STAR EXEMPTION, and **will be turning 65** by December 31, 2025, you could be eligible for ENHANCED STAR.

The income limit for the 2025-2026 school tax year is \$107,300, as verified by the 2023 Federal or State Income Tax Return. Income is Adjusted Gross MINUS any Taxable IRA Distributions. State Form IT-201 (Line 19 Minus 9) and Federal Form 1040 (Line 7 Minus the IRA Distribution).

ALL Enhanced STAR Exemption recipients, **MUST** apply to the IVP (Income Verification Program), even if you don't file tax returns. If you do not file income tax returns, Form RP-425-wkst must be completed.

If you are receiving the STAR CREDIT (a check from NYS), the State will be checking for age and income to verify your qualification.

You must meet the income and residency requirements; and apply no later than March 1, 2025.

NOTE FROM BUILDING INSPECTOR

Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detector: Now is a good time to replace batteries in smoke and carbon monoxide detectors going into the fall and winter season. Smoke/CO detectors should be replaced after 10 years of use with new 10-year battery smoke/CO detectors.

Fire Hydrants: Fire Code of NYS: A 3 foot clear space shall be maintained around the circumference of a fire hydrant.

Open Burning NYSDEC: Open Burning is permitted for small recreational fires including small cooking and campfires.

Burning of waste products or garbage is prohibited, including newspaper, paper products, plastic, chemically treated wood (pressure treated) and plywood. If you have a complaint regarding this, please contact the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation AT 1-877-457-5680. They are available 24/7

Brush pick up weeks are October 21st and November 18th, Then we are off until next year with the first pickup schedule for the week of March 17, 2025. Please have it to the road Sunday night. We pick up throughout the whole town. If you don't have it out by the time we come around, you will have to wait until the next month. Please refer to our guidelines on our website at elockport.com under highway department.

Refuse/Recycling: Please have your garbage and recycling out by 6 am. If it isn't picked up by 2 pm, call the highway clerk at 716-439-9522. Please remember you must use the town issued garbage cart. No other cart will be emptied.

Bags of Garbage: If you have bags which are over forty pounds, Modern will pick them up <u>during large item pick up week</u>. If they are less than forty pounds, you will need to purchase stickers from town clerk's office for \$5 each.

Bulk Pick Up: Modern will pick up 4 large items during the first full week of each month: October 7th – 11th, November 4th – 8th, December 2nd to 6th, January 6th – 10th 2025, February 3rd to 7th 2025. If they don't take it with the regular garbage truck, please be patient and they will come back with another truck. This includes any carpet/flooring/wood planks you may have. If a holiday falls on a Monday of the first full week of the month, large item pick up will be the following week.

The following rules are in place for the townwide brush pickup:

- Tree removal companies must take all of their own debris
- A maximum of one tandem truckload will be picked up at a time at any one residence
- No brush will be picked up that is stacked around fire hydrants, guardrails, vent pipes, signs or any other obstacle. We are not responsible for anything under a pile of brush that we cannot see. Keep in mind that we utilize large equipment to pick it up.

Come on out to see us on **Saturday, October 26th** to get those electronics properly recycled. This is your last opportunity for the year, **otherwise you'll need to hold on to these items until April of 2025**. As you know, this event is held right at Town Hall from 9 am – 1 pm. No need to get out of the vehicle, just pull up and we will do the rest.

Recycling electronics costs the town up to 9 cents a pound. Since we are not charging a fee for this service, we are limiting usage strictly to **Town of Lockport Residents** (please be prepared to show ID).

The hours of operation for the Town of Lockport Recycling Shed are: The last Saturday of each month, 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM, April through October.

NO after hour drop-offs will be permitted. Cameras are in place to protect and enforce the program. ACCEPTABLE ELECTRONIC RECYCLING LIST

- Televisions (CRT, LCD, LED, PLASMA, 3D)
- Computer Monitors (CRT, LCD, LED)
- Computers (Desktops & Laptops)
- Printers (Ink or Toner)
- Microwave Ovens
- Copiers/Fax Machines
- Video Equipment (VCR, DVD & Video Cameras)

Limit 4 large items (TV's) per month, open to Town of Lockport residents only.
